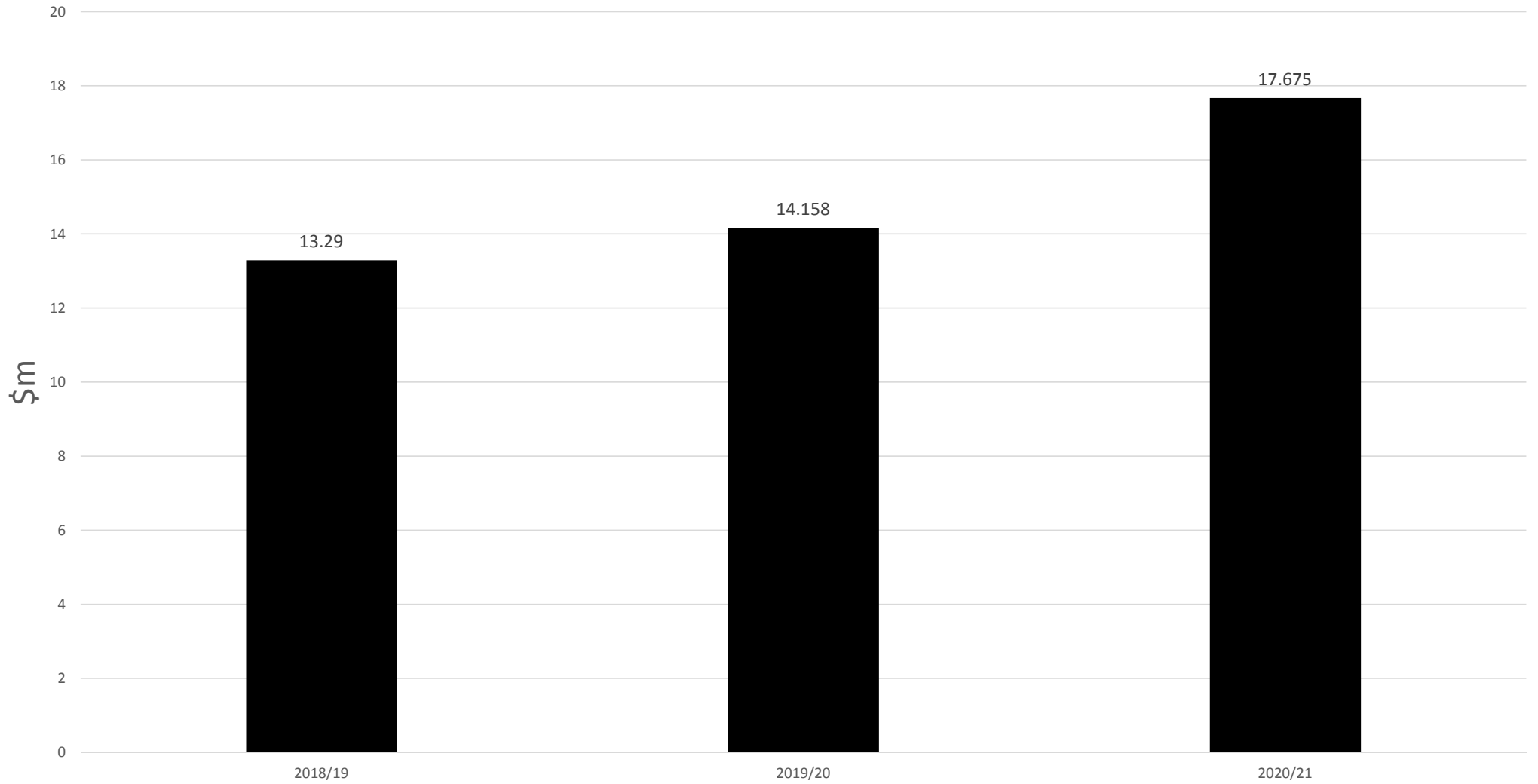

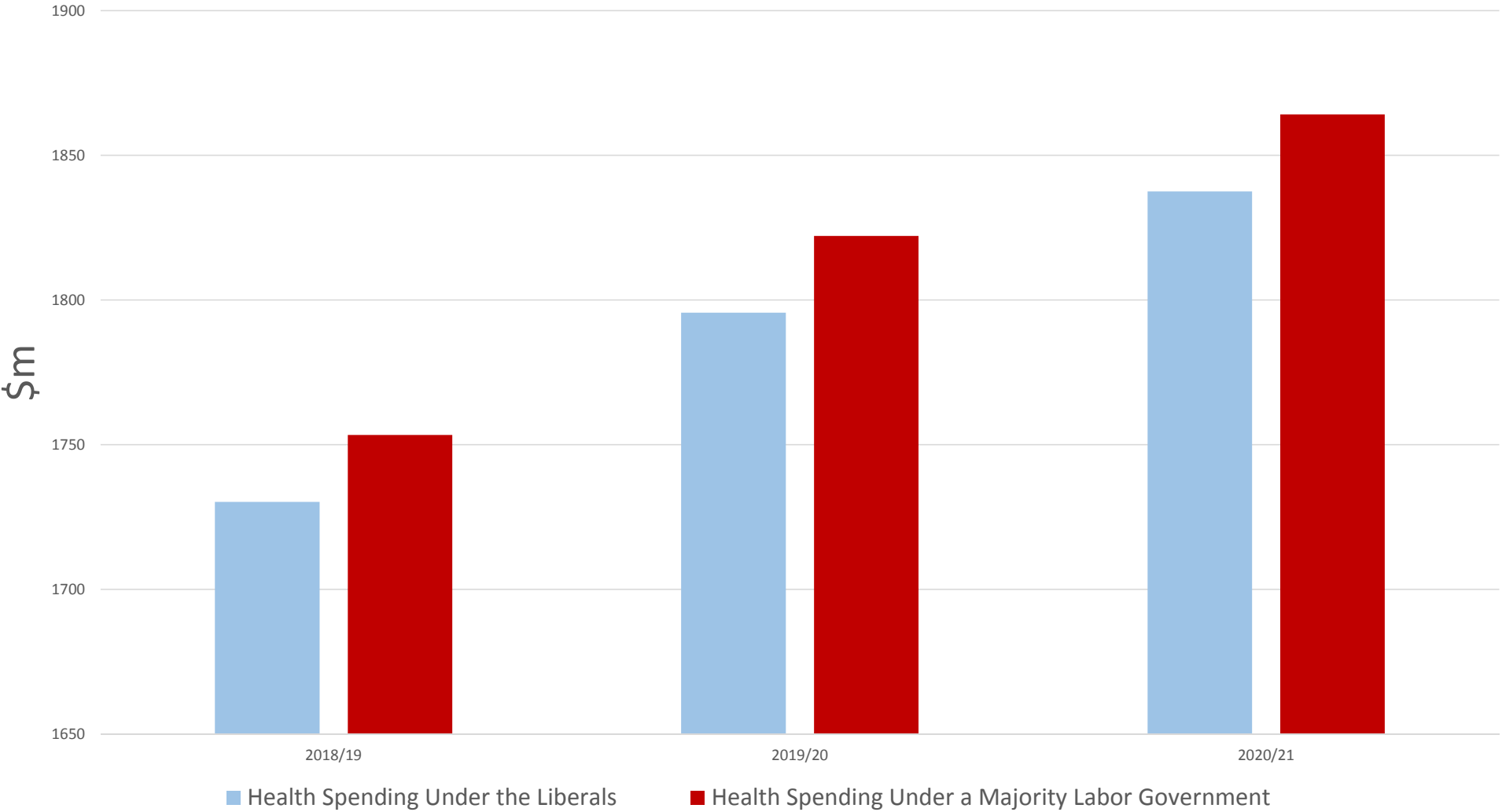

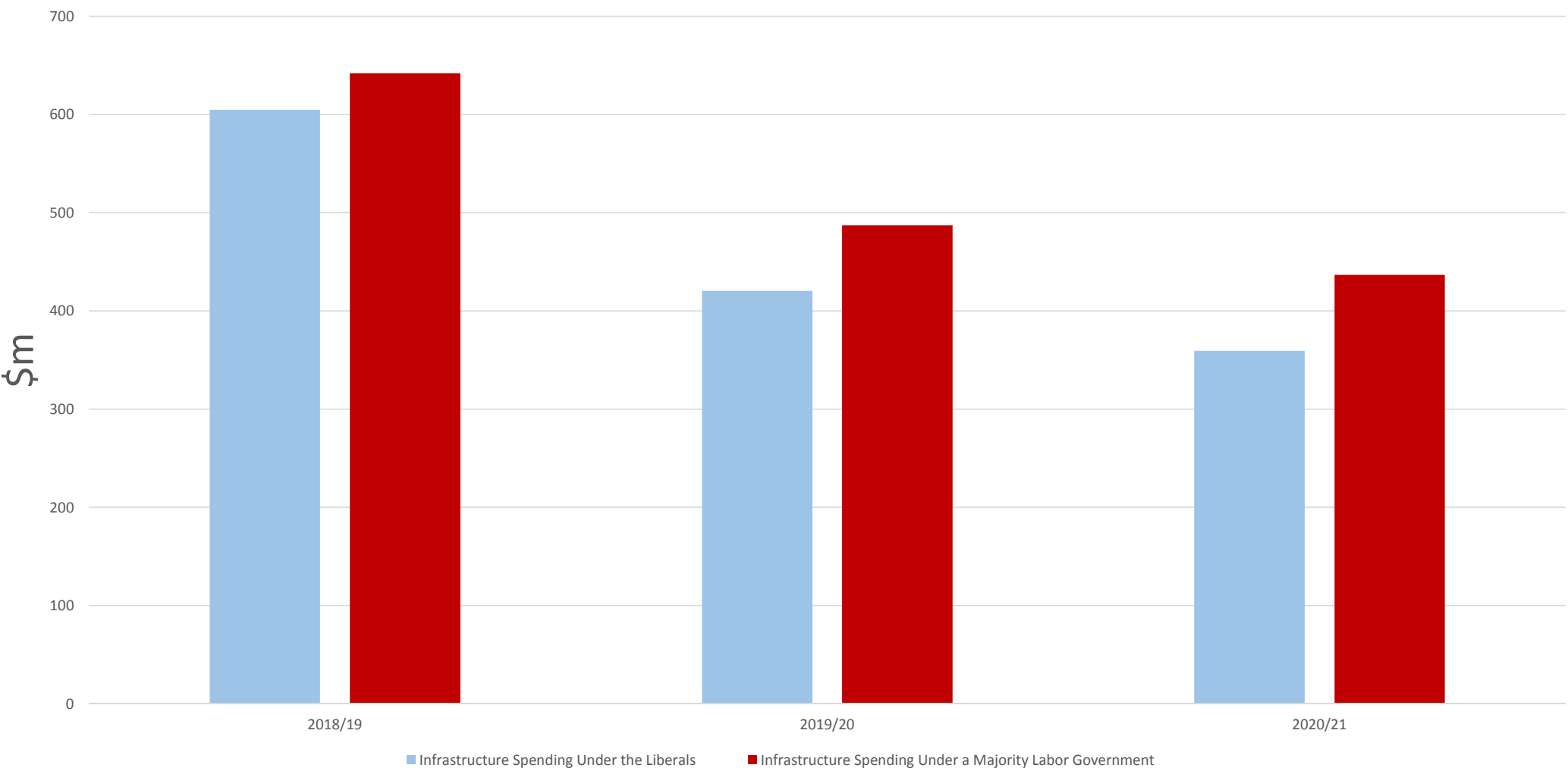
Labor's Net Operating Surplus

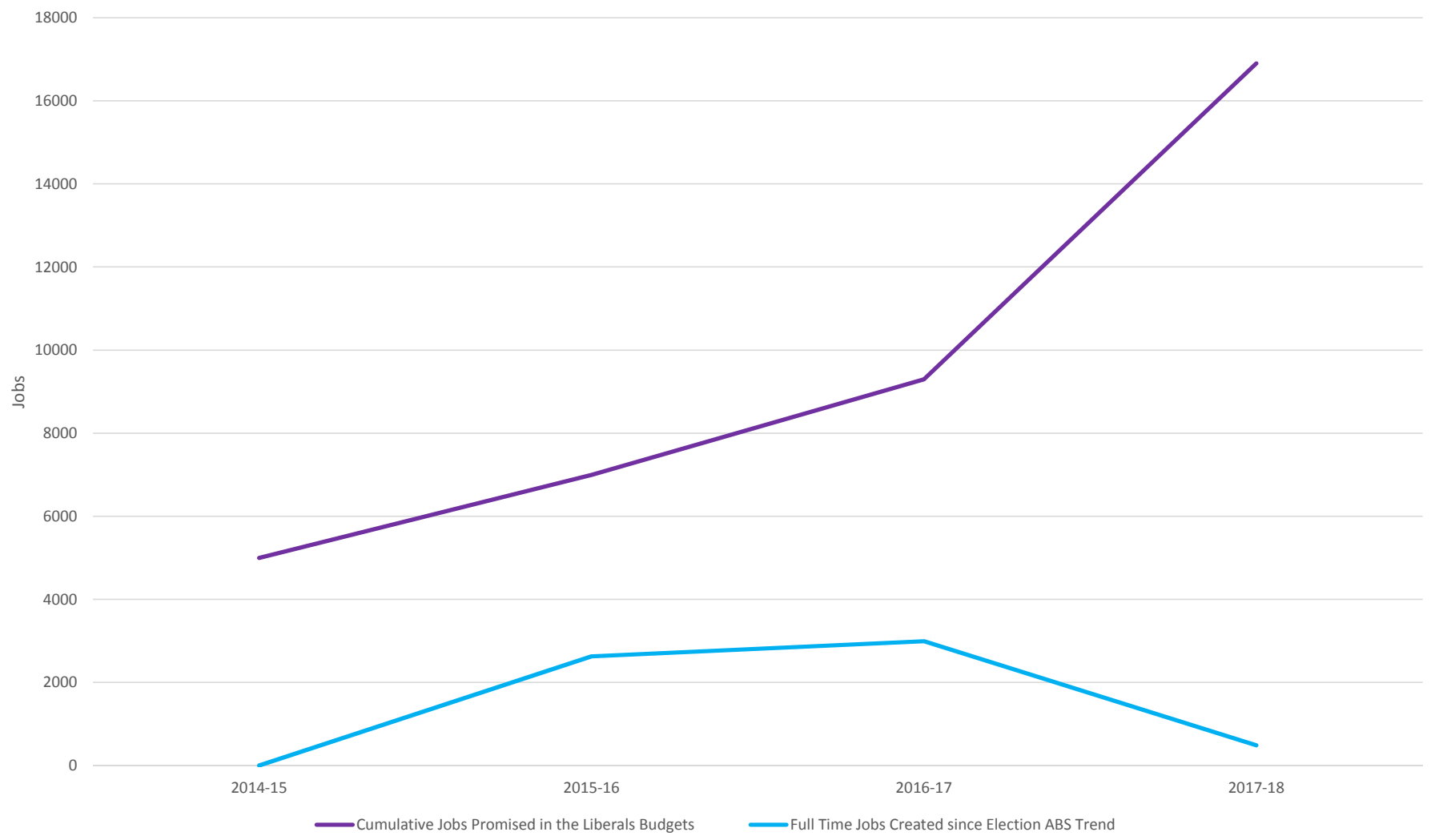

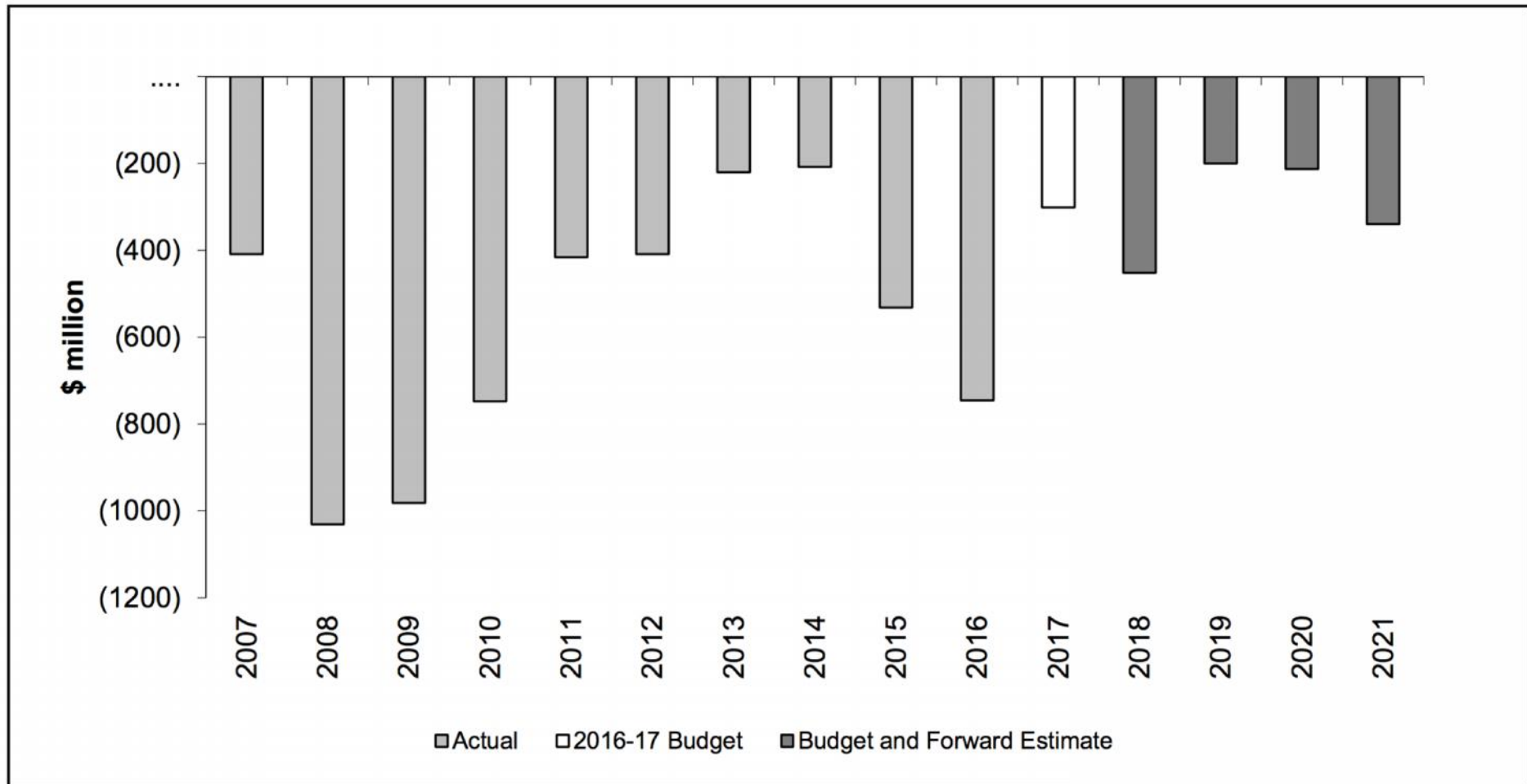

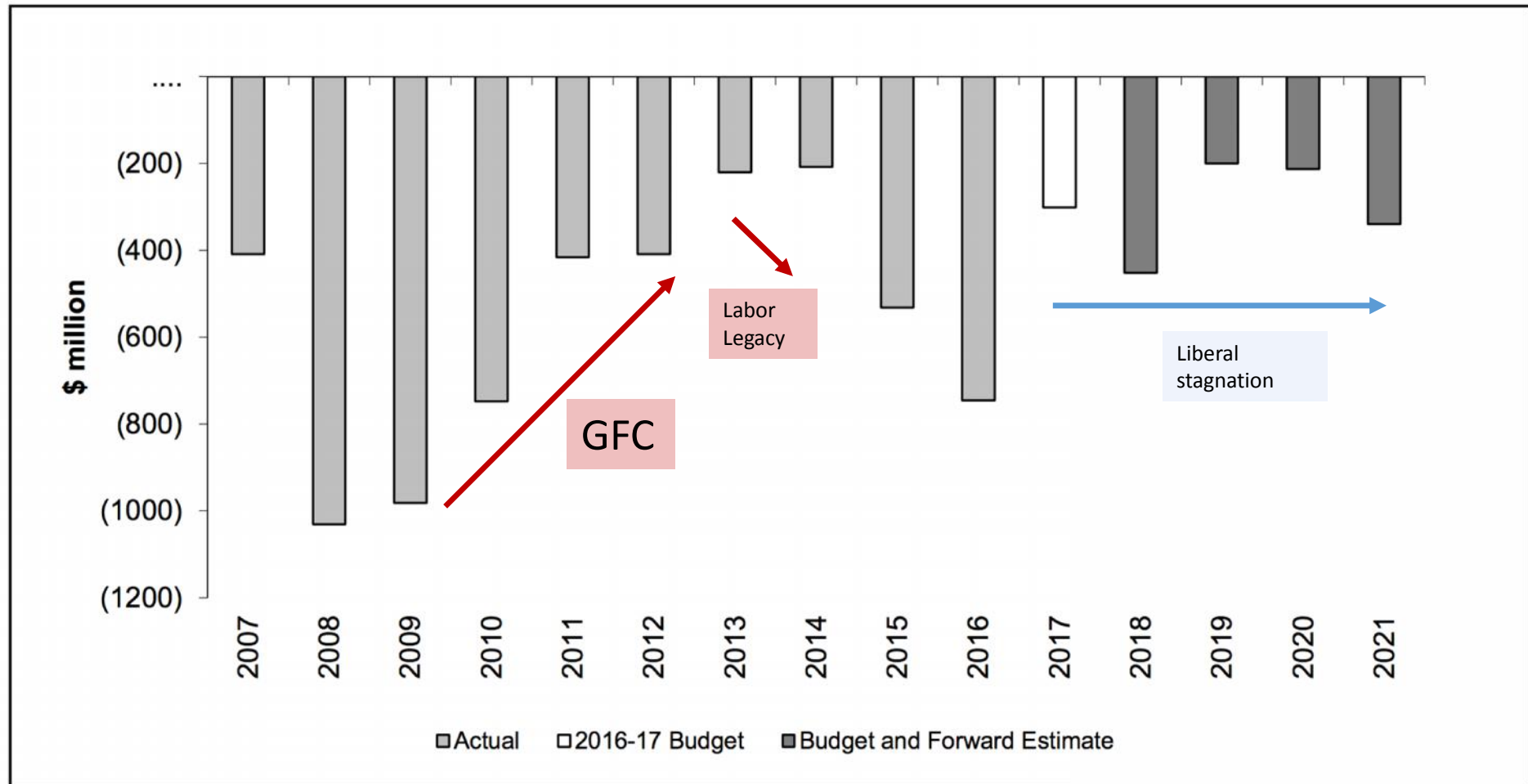

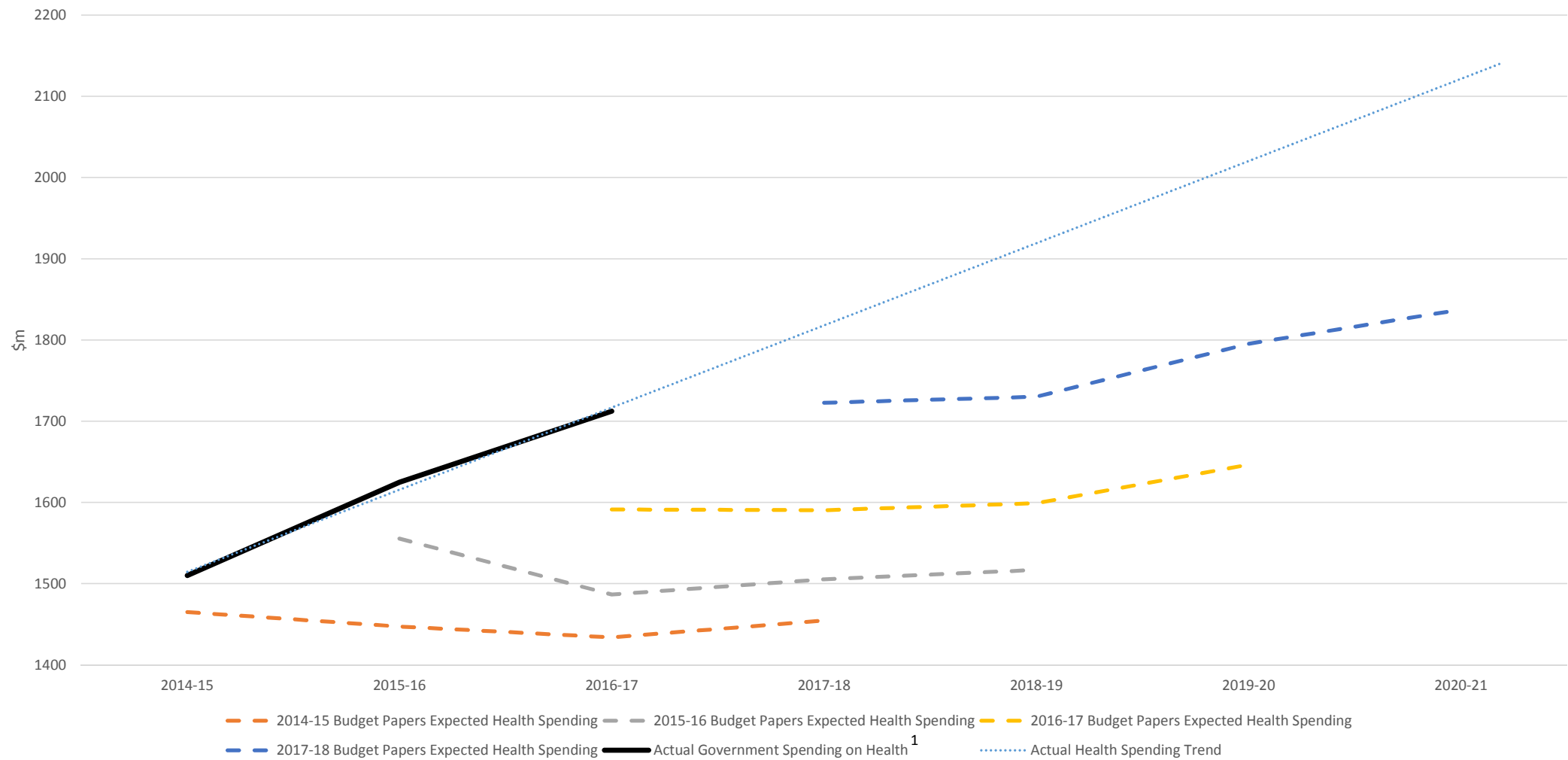
Net Debt, 2007 to 2021



Net Debt, 2007 to 2021

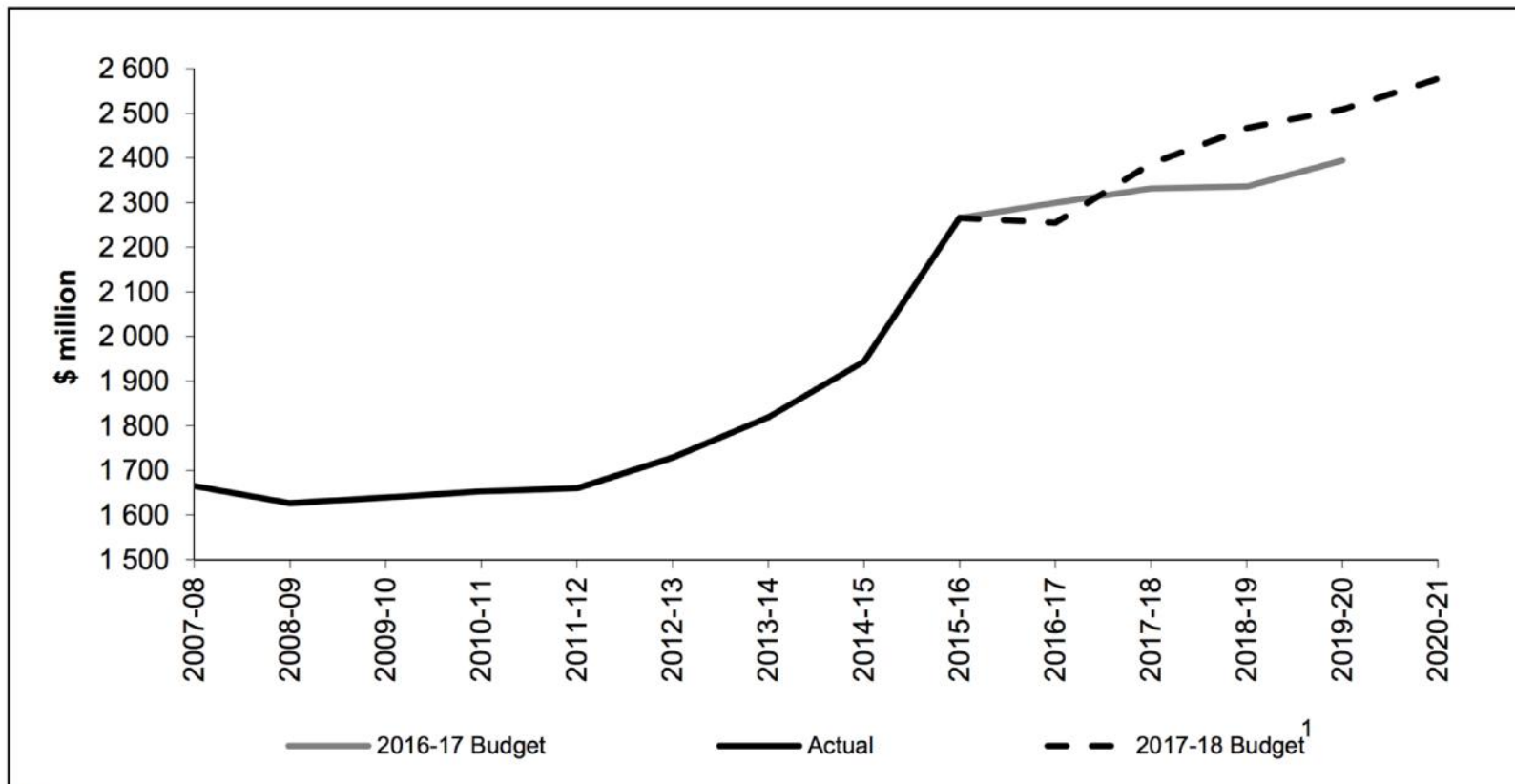


Health Spending
